The selected candidates will be responsible to construct, repair and maintain moulds by using the appropriate designs and machinery. The main tasks, amongst others, include:

- Manual work on plastic injection moulds.
- CAD/CAM programming, machining of electrodes, CNC-milling, lathe turning, spark & wire erosion or manual milling / drilling.
- To evaluate faults and correct accordingly.
- To ensure that machines and/or equipment function properly.
- To ensure that the workplace, machinery, tools and equipment within the department are maintained clean and organized.
